

# Lenox Place at Sunnyside Top Ten Keys to Neighborly Parking Awareness Month 2019

**1. All vehicles parked in Lenox Place at Sunnyside spaces on Courtland Cir. and Charles Ave. must display a Lenox Place hang tag.** Unauthorized vehicles are subject to ticketing or towing.

**2. Parking in fire lanes is always prohibited,** a City law subject to enforcement. Though Courtland Cir. and Charles Ave. look like streets, they are marked as fire lanes.

**3. All Lenox Place parking policies are posted on [www.lenoxplace.org](http://www.lenoxplace.org).** A Parking Committee of your neighbors helps support neighborly parking, safety and quality of life. Questions? Use “Contact” on the website.

**4. Our community has more homes than parking spaces.** Maximize your home’s garage and driveway parking before using scarce Lenox Place spaces.

**5. Public streets in and near Lenox Place are subject to City policy.** They include Shorter Ln., Elbert St., Old Dominion Blvd. and West Glebe Rd.

**6. Vehicles parked in driveways must not park with any wheel resting in the street or fire lane.** A car parked into the street may be ticketed or towed.

**7. Only persons authorized to park in individual posted Reserved spaces or their guests may do so.** They must also display Lenox Place hang tags. These spaces are reserved because their homes have neither driveways nor garages.

**8. Lenox Place owners are responsible to keep their tenants apprised of and compliant with HOA and city parking regulations.**

**9. Public street parking is available near Lenox Place** on Old Dominion Blvd. both south and north of West Glebe.

**10. A car may not park in any Lenox Place space for more than 7 days.** Such abandoned vehicles may be ticketed or towed.
